A Great Salvation

- Pay Close attention....let we drift v. 1
- Escape...Neglect...
 - 1st Question is – Who is Jesus?
 - 2nd Question is – What about his Message?
- So Great a Salvation
 1. Declared by the Lord
 2. Confirmed by those who heard
 3. Testified by signs, wonders, various miracles and gift of the Holy Spirit

Son's Humiliation and Glory

- Psalm 8 - The Son is the fulfillment
- Jesus is his name
- Jesus position on Earth (just like man)
- Jesus is crowned w/honor
 - Because he suffered
 - The Cross wasn't mistake
- Tasted Death for every one

The Savior of Mankind

1. The “Pioneer” ...made perfect – v.10
2. The “Sanctifier” is Christ – v.11
 - Sanctified are Christians
3. The “Brother” – v.11-13
 - Psalms 22, Isaiah 8:17-18
4. The “Liberator” – v. 14-16
 - Angels don’t get help...
5. The “High Priest” – v.17
6. The “Aid” or “Succor” – v.18

Jesus as the Pioneer of our Salvation

- Greek Word – archehos
 - Captain, Author, Leader
 - Pioneer

- Acts 3:15
- Acts 5:31

Jesus as the High Priest in Hebrews:

1. High Priest who makes propitiation
2. High Priest who is from the order of Melchizedek
3. High Priest who accomplishes atonement
4. High Priest who helps those in difficulty
5. High Priest who brings good things
6. High Priest of our confession
7. High Priest over the House of God
