Jesus as the Merciful and Faithful High Priest in Hebrews (2:17):

1. High Priest who makes propitiation for sins (2,7 & 8)
2. High Priest of our confession (3)
3. High Priest who helps those in difficulty (4)
4. High Priest after the order of Melchizedek (5,6 &7)
5. High Priest who brings good things (9)
6. High Priest over the House of God (10)

Drawing Near... (4:14-16)

1. 4:16 – Draw Near with Confidence to the throne of Grace
2. 6:19 – a hope that enters into the inner shrine...
3. 7:19 – through which we draw near to God
4. 7:25 – those who draw near to God...
5. 10:1 – make perfect those who draw near
6. 10:19 – we have confidence to enter to the sanctuary
7. 10:22 – let us draw near with a true heart
8. 11:6 – whoever would draw near to God

Found at the throne of God...

- 1) Grace- used 7 times in Hebrews 2:9, 4:16 (2), 10:29, 12:15, 13:9 and 13:25
- 2) Mercy
- 3) Help in time of need

Drawing near with Boldness (Confidence or Courage)....is the exhortation!!!

Qualifications of the High Priest

Earthly (v.1-4):

1. Taken from among men (v.1)
2. Called of God
3. From the Tribe of Levi (Ex. 28)

Christ (v.5-10):

- Called of God (v.5)
- “in the days of his flesh” (v.7-9)
- From the Tribe of Melchizedek
(Gen. 14:18 – Heb. 7)

“In the Days of his Flesh”

- 1) Offered up prayers and supplications (Lk. 22:41-44)
 - a. With strong tears
 - b. “to him” who was able to save him from death
- 2) Having been heard....(God heard and answered his prayer)
- 3) Learned Obedience by the things he suffered
- 4) Having been made perfect...he became a “author/pioneer”

Pause....

- 1) What does this passage teach us about Christ?
 - ✘ Shows how hard it was for him to leave Heaven

- 2) What does this passage teach us about Prayer?
 - ✘ The substance of our prayers

- 3) What does this passage teach us about the Love of God?
 - 1) Sending of his Son
 - 2) The example of going through suffering to be perfected!!!
