Follow up from Chap 17 & 18

- Make-up of Rome (Iron and Clay) (c17:12)
- Pre-Millennial View:
 - Future “Roman-type” Nation
 - European Common Market – 10 Kings
- Problems with Jerusalem/Rome as the Harlot
 - Neither have been un-inhabited
 - Neither fit the “fall in one day” (18:8, 18:17)
- Must Shortly come to pass
 - Jerusalem is Siege in 70 AD
 - Roman History

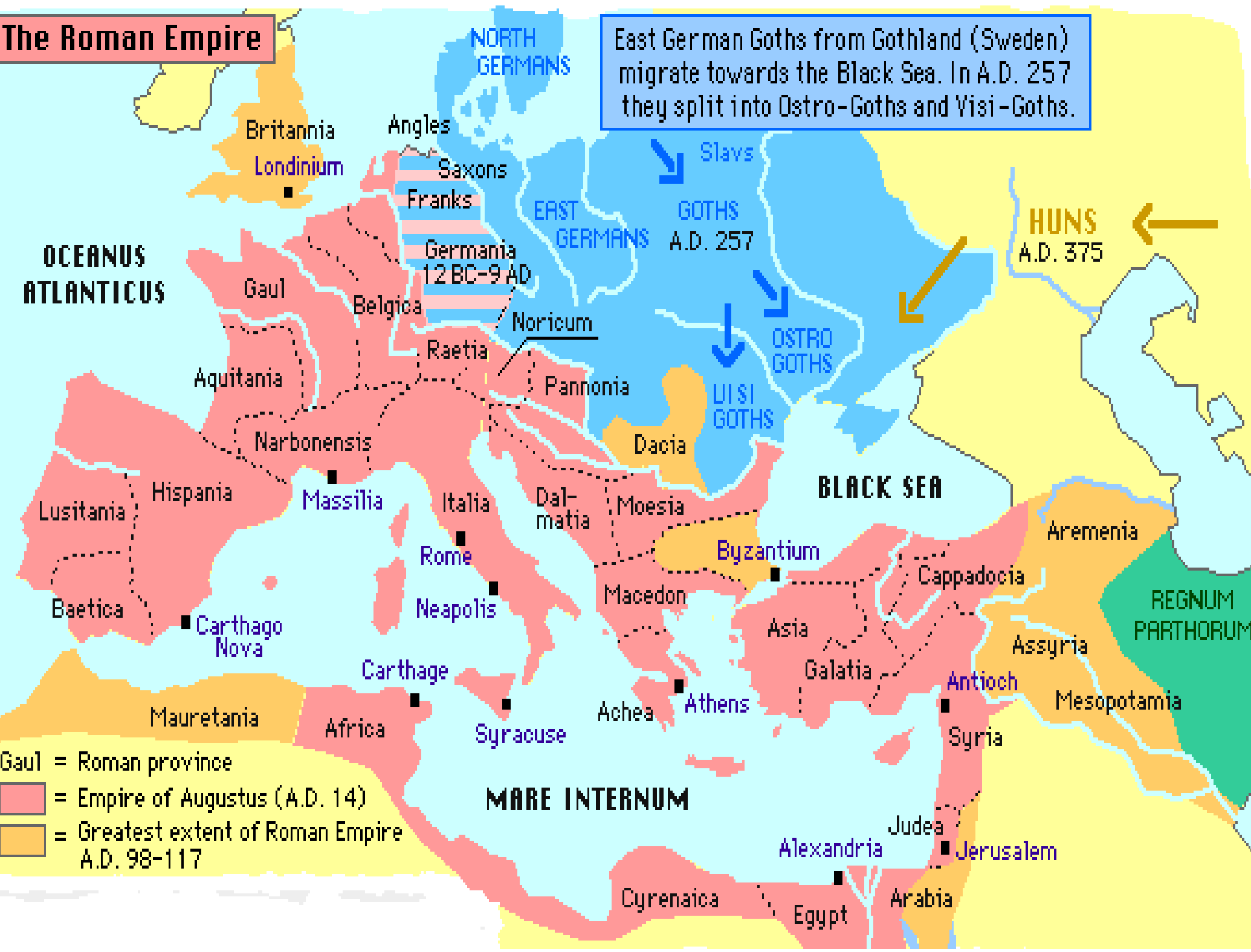
Roman History

- Domitian (81-96 AD) – Persecute Christian
- Relative Peace for Rome thru 300 AD (Constantine)
 - 160 AD – Antoninus Pius – Population = 1,000,000
 - 300 AD – Power Moved to the East – Constantinople
- 370 AD – Goths invade Rome
- 400 AD – Visigoth invade Rome
 - 410 AD – Sacking of Rome (Augustine/Jerome write pages on this)
- 590 AD – Population of Rome is 20,000

We tend to forget the “prestige of Rome” vanished

The Roman Empire

East German Goths from Gothland (Sweden) migrate towards the Black Sea. In A.D. 257 they split into Ostro-Goths and Visi-Goths.

Rejoicing and the Feast

- Multitudes Rejoicing
 - Chap 18 ends w/the World Merchants Mourning
 - Praising God's Righteousness
 - 24 Elders say "Amen & Hallelujah"
- Marriage Feast is Introduced
 - The Bride contrasts the Harlots (actions/apparel)
 - Blessed are those invited to the Feast

Conqueror and the Great Supper

- Conqueror Introduced
 - Riding a White Horse
 - Has a Name that no one know
 - Robe Dipped in Blood (Treads the Winepress)
- Great Supper of God
 - Armageddon (?)
 - Beast (s) thrown into the Lake of Fire
- Reverse Judging of Introduction
 - Introduce: Satan, Beast (s) and Harlot
 - Judge: Harlot, Beast (s) and Satan
